KEHILAT CHAVERIM respects the diversity of American Judaism; Offering a welcoming atmosphere for families, individuals, mixed/blended marriages and relationships, and alternative lifestyles. We have no Rabbi or building and the members organize and run all of our own programs through a cooperative atmosphere.

Founded in 1978, we are a Jewish community that takes a parent-directed, cooperative approach to Jewish education.

Our curriculum is steeped in culture and tradition but not defined by it.

At Kehilat Chaverim Sunday School your child will learn about Jewish history, Holidays and Culture. With a strong emphasis placed on personal ethics and social action; Allowing the students a variety of ways to explore their Jewish identity.

\$470 - 1st child

\$380 - each additional child

Sunday School Deposit: \$75.00 per child

****Kehilat Chaverim membership dues:**

\$75 annually for one-adult households

\$120 annually for multi-adult households
